Bring plants, or take plants, you can bring plants & not take plants, or take plants & not bring plants, or take plants & bring plants.

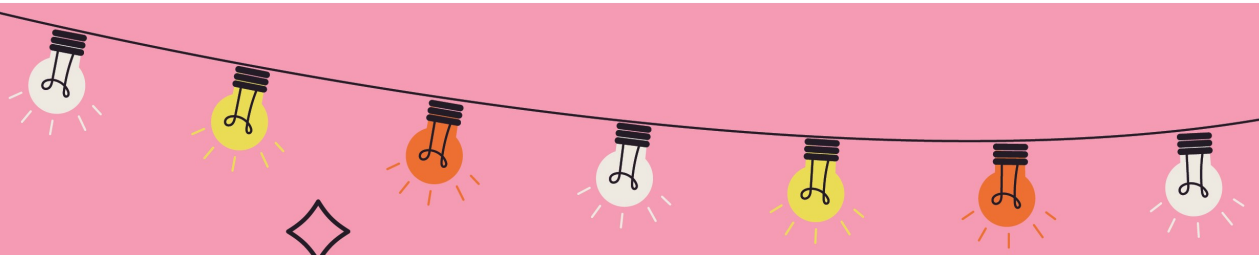

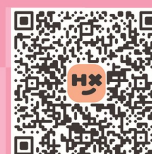
