### Digital Technology Evening at CQS

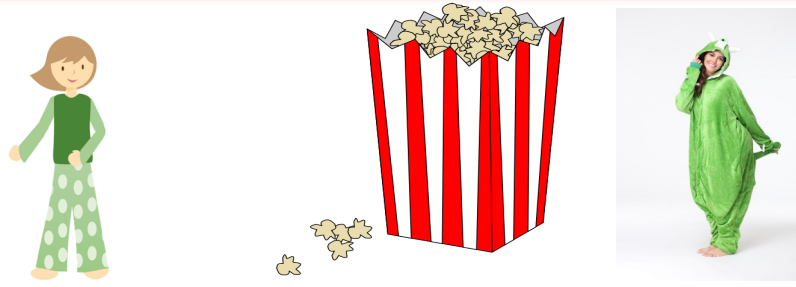
