Clyde Quay School ENROLMENT FOR 2023

The Board invites applications from parents who live outside of the home zone and who wish to enrol their child at Clyde Quay School in 2023. Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office.

Applications can be made by returning a completed enrolment form available from the school office or on the school website www.clydequay.school.nz. The deadline for receipt of applications for out of zone places is 12 noon Friday 4 November 2022.

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year.

The board has determined that a total of 25 places are likely to be available for out of zone students next year in all year levels. The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

If the number of out of zone applicants exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot. If a ballot is required, it will be held on 4 November 2022. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.
