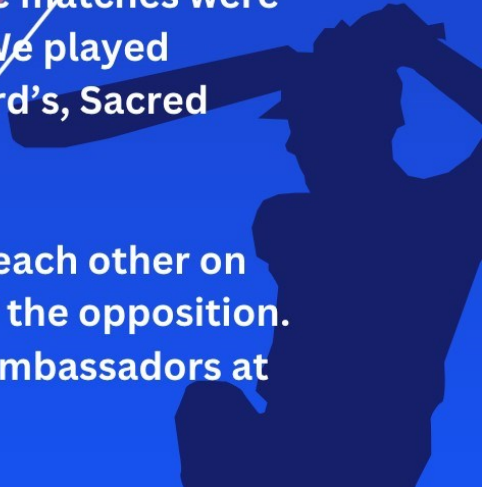


Central Zone Schools' NON-STOP CRICKET TOURNAMENT


Wellington Harriers Children's' Cross Country Open day is Saturday 6th April at 1.45pm.
