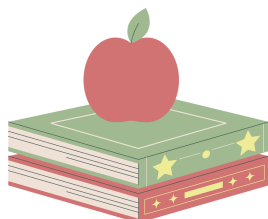
## CQS ACTIVITIES & SPORT

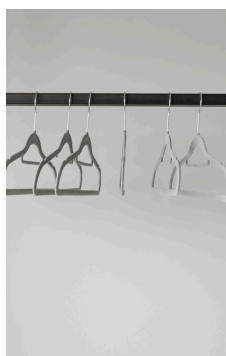


