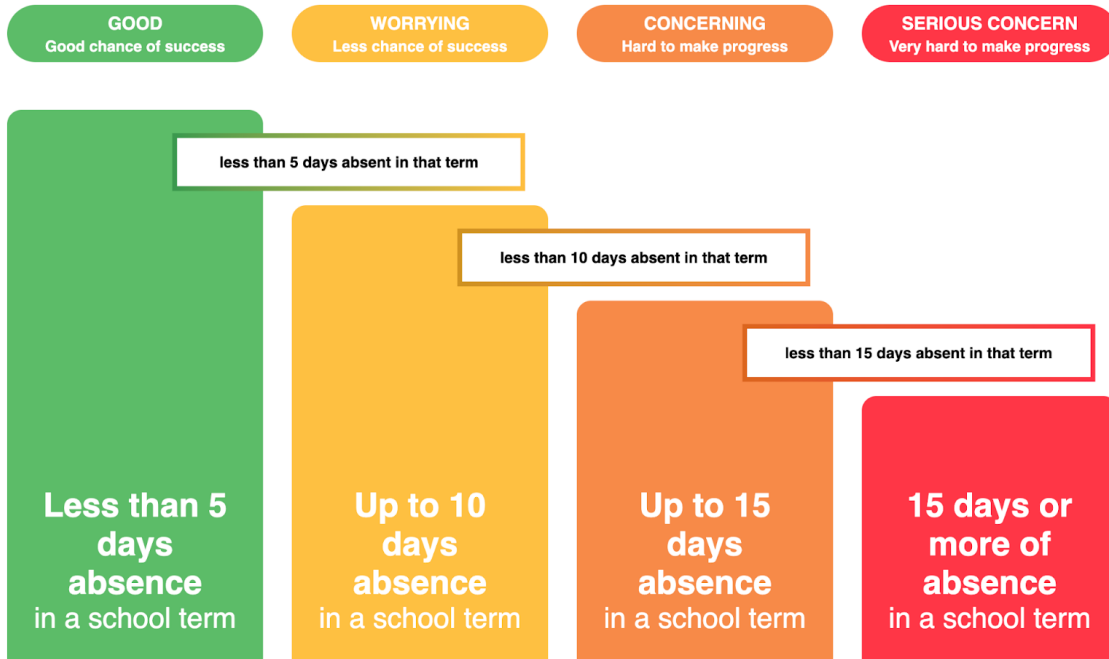

If your child is absent, please inform us as soon as possible. There are many ways that you can do this, please choose the one that works best for you. You can:

- Phone the school and leave an absence message
- Email Laurelle at office@clydequay.school.nz
- Use the Skool Loop or eTap app

Every school's attendance data is sent daily to the Ministry of Education. It is important that you let us know the reason for your child's absence or their absence will be recorded as "unjustified" or "truant".

We understand that there are genuine reasons for absences and continue to ask that if your child is sick to keep them home. If your child has repeated absences, we may reach out to offer support.

Crypto outbreak in Wellington Region

You may or may not be aware of the cryptosporidiosis (crypto) outbreak in the wellington region.

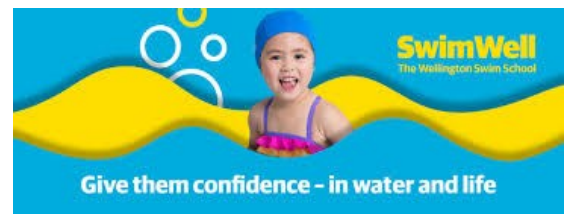
Crypto is a stomach bug that spreads easily in water and can cause:

- Smelly, watery diarrhea.
- Stomach cramps.
- Nausea and vomiting.
- Fever and dehydration.

The important thing for schools to think about are the following to help keep our pools safe:

- Students who are or have been sick, please keep away from the pool, crypto spreads easily in water.
- If a student has had crypto? They need to stay out of the pool for at least two weeks after symptoms stop to prevent spreading it to others.
- Wash hands well, especially after using the toilet.

The Board invites applications from parents who live outside of the home zone and who wish to enrol their child at Clyde Quay School in Term 2, 2025. Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available at the school office.

Applications can be made by returning a completed enrolment form available from the school office or on the school website www.clydequay.school.nz. The deadline for receipt of applications for the out of zone process is 12 noon Wednesday 9th April 2025.

Parents of students who live within the school zone are always welcome to fill out an enrolment form and start at the school. We always appreciate as much notice as possible to help us with planning.

The Board has determined that a total of 4 places are available for out of zone students in New Entrant, Year 1, Year 2 Year 3, and Year 4 levels for students starting in Term 2.

If you have an out of zone student who will start in Term 3 or Term 4, we will be holding a separate ballot for these terms, with dates to be announced via our newsletter in Week 1 of next term.

If the number of out of zone applicants exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot. If a ballot is required it will be held on Thursday 10th April. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three days of the ballot being held.
